Dr. McNeil received an AB degree in Chemistry from Emmanuel College, her M.D. from Harvard Medical School and her Ph.D. from Harvard University.

“My research has focused largely on identifying the most appropriate, effective and highest quality medical technologies and imaging procedures for patients, and I have dedicated my career to improving patient care,” said Dr. McNeil. “I am looking forward to working with AG Mednet to help hospitals and research centers accomplish this goal by improving diagnostic imaging exchange, connecting peer networks of doctors and researchers and, ultimately, providing the best medical care to the people who need it.”
